


WHY ARE WE DIFFERENT?

We are the only event management course provider to be accredited by the globally recognised Chartered Institute of Marketing. It took nearly two years to earn this accreditation and we are very proud of it.


This accreditation is valued by employers globally and recognised as a high quality academic and vocational qualification - studying with us means your CV stands out from the crowd.

WHERE WILL I LEARN?

Our lectures take place at the Business Design Centre (BDC), a beautiful Grade II listed building in Islington, London.

The BDC is also home to a range of creative businesses including iconic British clothing retailer Barbour and cutting-edge marketing and brand experts, Contagious. Throughout the year, the BDC hosts exhibitions in the central space including fashion, art and design and digital media.

Just 5 minutes walk from Angel tube station and 10 minutes from Kings Cross St Pancras, travelling to the Business Design Centre is easy. Islington has plenty of shops, cafes and restaurants to meet up with friends and fellow students.

All of our courses are also available to study online, allowing students from all over the world to study with us. With our online courses students learn in bite-sized chunks; all of our online courses have been designed so students can fit them around their work and family commitments.

ACCOMODATION, VISAS & STUDY OPTIONS

Do you provide accommodation?

Unfortunately we do not provide any student accommodation, however our Admissions Team can point you towards some useful websites to search for accommodation if you wish. If you are budgeting for accommodation you should think of a minimum of £500 per month for a room in a house/flat in London – this would not include house bills (e.g. electricity) and your other costs (e.g. food, travel etc).

Can you help with visa applications?

Our courses are open to international students, however, we are unable to assist with or support visa applications as we are not a Tier 4 sponsor. Our Admissions Team will always try to help with any questions but we are unable offer formal assistance with visa applications process. Are the courses full or part-time?

Our courses are available to study in a variety of ways but to give you a quick overview:

- Degree Alternative full-time
- Postgraduate Diploma full-time

- Certificate full-time
- All online courses part-time

Can I do volunteering?

To help you build your experience and develop your industry network we offer volunteering to all of our students and alumni, whatever course you study with us, live or online. Recent volunteering opportunities include The Brit Awards, Secret Cinema, the LGBT Awards, British Summer Time Festival, Wilderness Festival and Ted X Brighton.

Students can volunteer throughout their course and for three months afterwards - after this students can join The Loop, our alumni membership programme to continue to access all of our volunteering opportunities.







Do all the courses have work placements?

Only our Degree Alternative and Postgraduate courses include a three month work placement. With help from our sister company The Event Talent Agency, students choose from 800 agencies, venues, charities and corporate placements as part of the Degree Alternative and Postgraduate courses.

Recent placement companies include Virgin Sport, Mama Festivals, The Department, Netjets, WRG & Imagination.

Can I just do a work placement without studying a course?

No, we only offer our placements as part of our Degree Alternative and Postgraduate courses. We are able to place students in high profile companies because they have completed courses with us and are work-ready.







QUALIFICATIONS

What qualifications do I need?

Our entry requirements are flexible so we interview all our students prior to offering them a place (either in person or over the phone). We are looking for a number of things:

- A positive, can-do attitude
- Good written and spoken English
- Previous, relevant event experience
- Previous qualifications

Do I need event experience?

It always helps to have some experience of events no matter how big or small. This will give you an idea of where you might like your career to take you in the event industry and give you an insight into the fundamentals of putting an event together.



Is there a minimum or maximum age?

We don't have a maximum age for our courses but we do require students to be a minimum of 18 years old to study with us.

COURSE SUITABILITY

What is the typical age range of students?

Each level of course has a slightly different demographic but we welcome students of all ages (18+) onto our courses. To give you a rough idea our Degree Alternative tends to attract students aged between 18 – 25, Postgraduate between 21 – 35, Diploma between 22 – 45 and Foundation Certificate between 18 – 50. Please do check with us if you have any concerns about which course would suit you best. You are never too old and rarely too young (as long as you are over 18) to study events management.

What is the qualification equivalent / degree?

All of our courses are accredited by the Chartered Institute of Marketing so they provide a formal qualification that is globally recognised by employers. Each course also has an equivalent level as follows:

- Foundation Certificate (live and online): Level 3 (this is the same level as an A Level qualification)
- **Diploma (live and online):** Level 4 (this is the same level as a Certificate of Higher Education)
- Postgraduate & Degree Alternative (live and online): Level 7 (this is the same level as a Masters qualification)
